



TERMS OF COMPETITION FOR NORTHERN COUNTIES' SENIORS' AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP.

1. These Terms of Competition should be read in conjunction with the General Terms of Competition for NCGU events. Play will be under the NCGU Hard Card available on the NCGU website (NCGU.co.uk).
2. The Championship is open to any male amateur playing member whose **HOME CLUB** is affiliated to one of the County Unions of Cheshire, Cumbria, Durham, Isle of Man, Lancashire, Northumberland and Yorkshire.
3. The entrant must have attained the age of 55 years on or before the day of the Championship and must have a handicap index not exceeding 12 at the time of entry.
4. 135 Competitors shall be eligible to compete. In the event of entries being oversubscribed, a ballot will be held of the higher handicapped players, and where necessary, by age groups in the proportions provided by the Rules.
5. The winner will be the competitor who returns the lowest gross stroke play aggregate score over 36 holes (18 holes on each of 2 consecutive days). His name will be engraved on The Northern Counties' Seniors' Amateur Championship Trophy presented by EAC Denham in 1991, and will receive a memento. Cheques will be awarded to the first three places.
6. Subsidiary competitions (gross stroke play scores over 36 holes) will also be played within the Championship in the age groups of 55-59, 60-64, 65-69 and 70 and over. No competitor shall receive more than one prize and ties will be decided as provided by the rules.
7. If play has to be suspended because of adverse weather conditions, and it is impractical to continue on the following day, the winner shall be decided over 18 holes. If 18 holes have not been completed, then play shall be abandoned and another date arranged when play may be over 18 or 36 holes at the discretion of the Championship Committee.
8. All entries are made online via Golf Genius via the website (ncgu.co.uk). Entry will be available from 06:00 on 4th April 2022 until 18:00 on 5th July 2022. The acceptance or refusal of entries shall be referred to the Championship Committee whose decision is final.
